*1. Complete this application.

*2. Provide a copy of your voter's registration card. To register to vote, you must be:

- **A U.S. citizen;**
- **A Maryland resident; and**
- **At least 16 years old*.**

***You may register to vote if you are at least 16 years old but cannot vote unless you will be at least 18 years old by the next general election.**

*3. Insert **three Letters of Recommendation** with contact information and signature from different people (**Excluding Family Members**). All letters of recommendation must be address to: **Maryland State Senator Barbara A. Robinson, Attn: Scholarship Committee, 2901 Druid Park Drive, Suite 200 D, Baltimore, Maryland 21215.** There must be a subject line to indicate that it is a **Letter of Recommendation in bold lettering.** Example: **(RE: Letter of Recommendation for Jane Doe.)**

*4. Write a 300-Word Essay as to **How this scholarship would help you financially and academically.** All essays must have the scholarship recipients name in the upper right hand corner and have a subject line to reference: **How This Scholarship Will Help Academically and Financially.** The essay must be typed and double-spaced.
